Numbers are restricted to a maximum of 30 in classrooms, 90 in the New Hall and 210 in the Main Hall. In order to accommodate our anticipated turnout, we will need to restrict numbers to two per family, one for parent/carer and the other for our student (this does not include under 12s who do not need a ticket). When booking tickets, please book an entry ticket (this will need to be produced on arrival) you will then need to book into each session that you wish to attend, have a copy of the schedule open (at the bottom of this letter) so that you can work out the order of the sessions you want to attend. Tickets for each session will be available on a first come first served basis, the Eventbrite booking system will be open on Wednesday 24th April 3pm and close on 6th May at 12pm.
