French AQA – 8658 German AQA – 8668 Spanish AQA - 8698</p> <p>Throughout the year in all three languages, students are taught to develop their speaking, listening, reading, writing and translation skills.</p> <p>The topics covered are identity and culture, local, national, international and global areas of interest and current and future study and employment.</p> <p>All aspects of grammar are covered throughout the course, including past, present and future tenses. We also practise and refine translation skills.</p>	<p>Teachers will continually assess students' performance across the key skills throughout the year and record their attainment.</p> <p>Students will be tested formally in the allocated assessment week on the school calendar.</p> <p>All examinations contributing towards the final GCSE grade will take place in Y11 and are externally assessed, contributing 25% each towards the overall grade.</p> <p>Classwork and homework will be marked in line with the MFL Departmental policy which is stuck in the front of all student exercise books.</p> <p>One piece of extended written work, will be deep marked with WWW/EBI comments per half term.</p>	<p>The purpose of homework set in MFL is to consolidate the learning that happens in the classroom and develop the four key skills of reading, listening, writing and speaking.</p> <p>The MFL department aims to set homework once per week.
