Please note that whilst most students will begin Y12 studying four AS level subjects, this can be demanding (particularly if entry grades are not high) and, depending on their academic report, we may advise some students to choose three instead.

Because we work on four timetabling blocks, it is not structurally possible to study more than four AS Levels, without missing significant amounts of teaching usually in two subjects.
