Attendance at the UK Universities and Apprenticeships Fair at the University of Sheffield

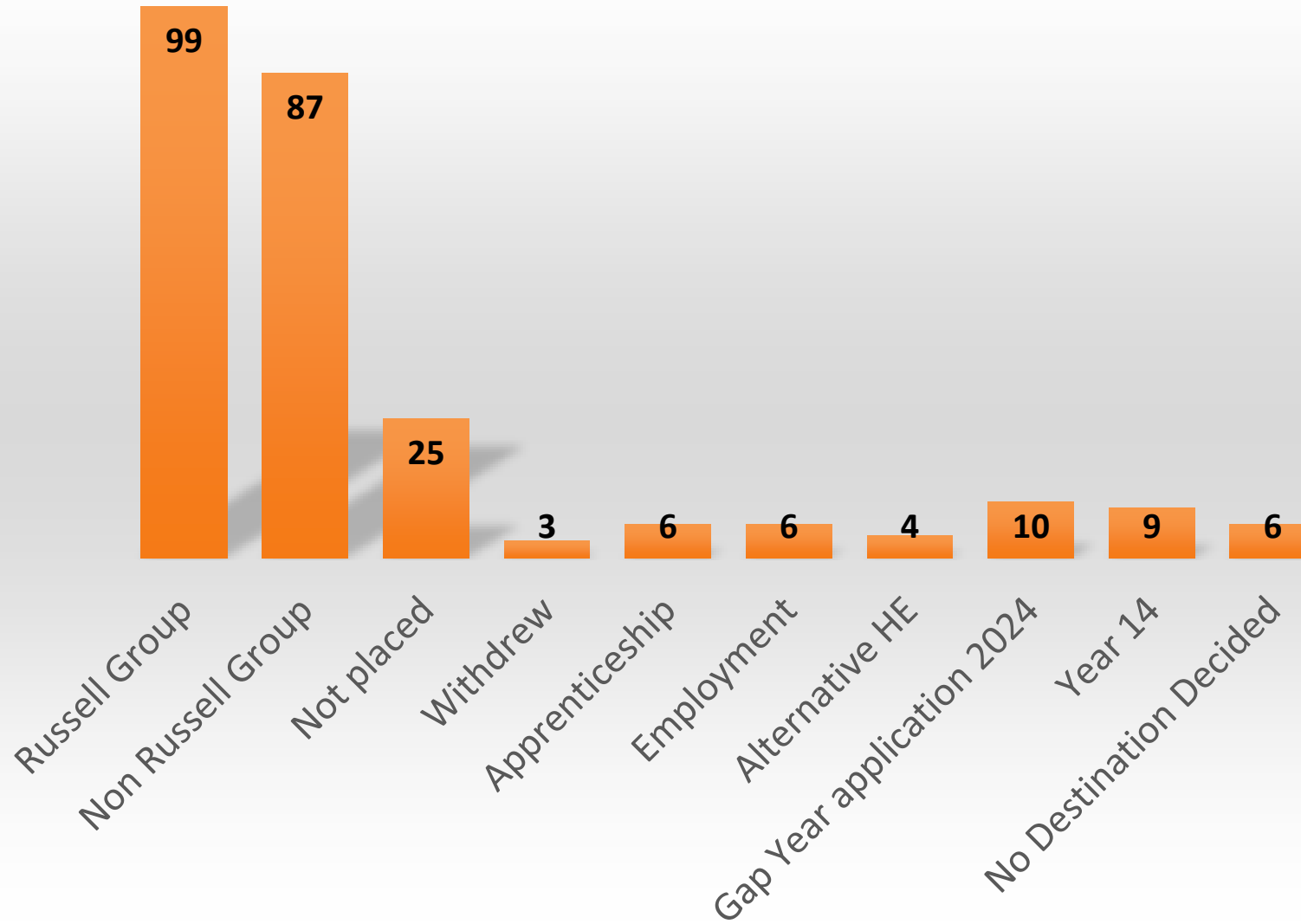
Outreach from the University of Sheffield, Sheffield Hallam University, Imperial College, London, Oxford University, Cambridge University and many others.

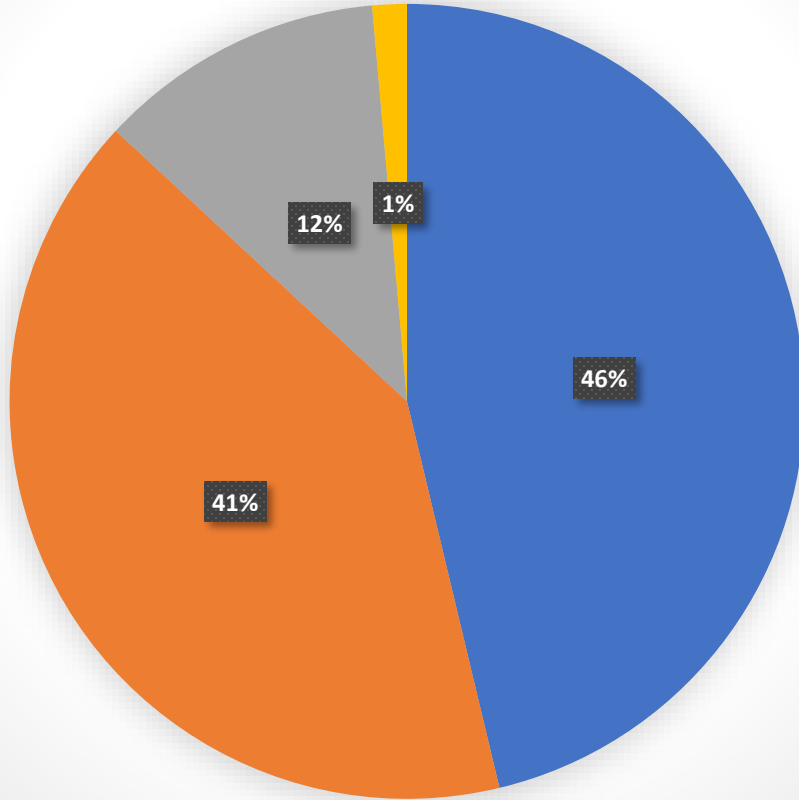

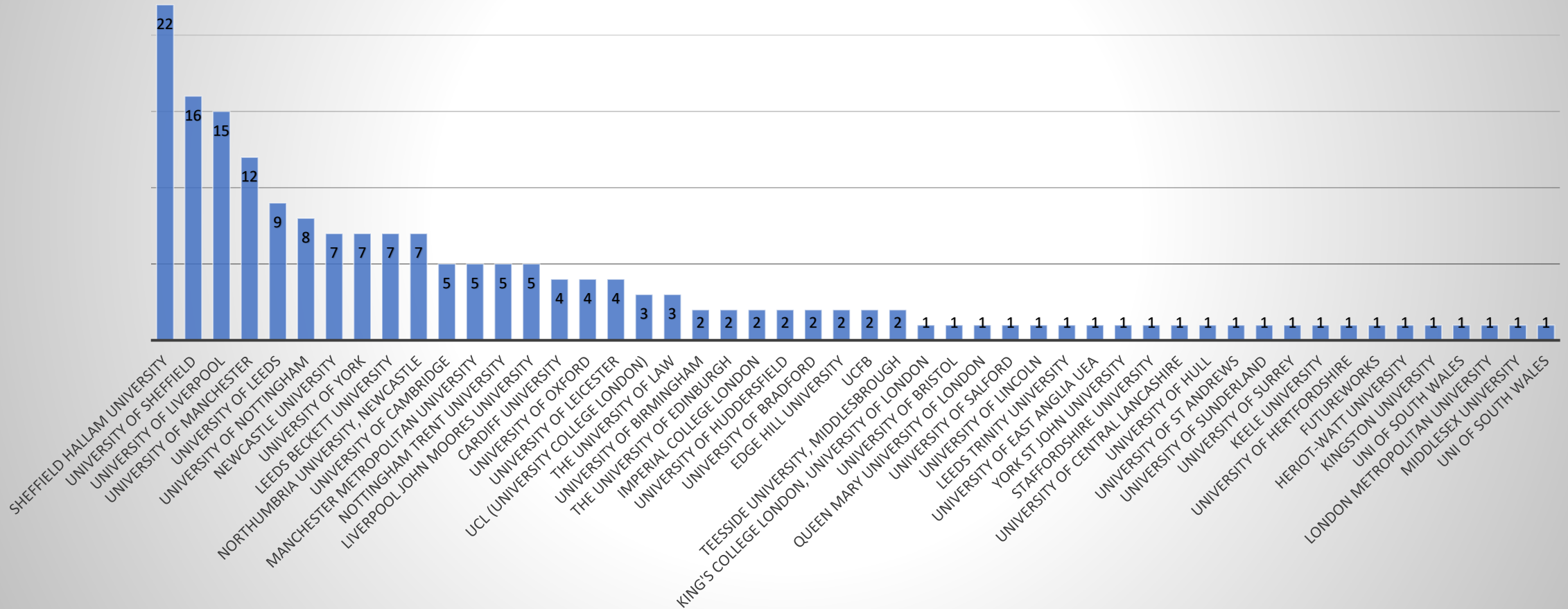


Firm and Insurance Choices Russell Group v Non Russell Group
