End of KS5 Challenge – This is the TSAT A level target grade.

Assessment % Paper 1 - This is the percentage mark achieved in Paper 1.

Assessment % Paper 2 - This is the percentage mark achieved in Paper 2. Please note not all subjects set two assessments.

Grade achieved in Assessment – This is the overall grade achieved in the assessment(s).

UCAS Predicted Grade – An aspirational but achievable predicted grade determined by professional judgement. This information will be used by students to support their post-18 applications.

Behaviour for Learning – This is stated as a number from 4 to 1 as referenced in the grid below.
