A Level Results Day Thursday 15th August 2024

Dear students, parents and carers,

We would firstly like to congratulate all Year 13s on completing their examinations; they can now look forward to a long and well-deserved summer holiday!

A Level results will be released to students on Thursday 15th August. Year 13 students will need to arrive in form groups to collect their results; timings for each form group are detailed in the table below. Year 12 students collecting results will need to arrive at 1pm. Students who are unable to collect their results will need to contact school in writing if they wish to nominate an individual to collect them on their behalf; nominated individuals will need to bring a form of photo identification to collect the results and arrive at the allocated time for the child they are representing. These letters must be brought to school before the end of the academic year. Please be aware school emails are not routinely checked over the school holidays and therefore contacting school via email during this time will not guarantee receipt of your communication.

Please also note that all results will be sent out via email to the student's school email account by 8.30pm on Results Day.

A Level examination results day is on Thursday 15th August in the school hall; timings for each form are below.

Sixth Form staff will be available 8am until 3pm on Results Day to support students. We will then be available 9am until 12pm on Friday 16th August, should you wish to come into school for support. If you would like to prepare for Results Day please refer to the link below:

If you will be abroad when the results are released, you will not be able to access your school email, and we will not be able to respond to a non-school email account. You must complete a Microsoft Form that was sent to students' school email address so that we can enable your email to work abroad.

It is incredibly important that we receive all school property back before the students leave, including all photo ID cards, lanyards, and text books. Some text books have deposits attached to them. The £5 ID card deposit will be returned to students when they return their card and lanyard, if they have not had to order a replacement at any point. Students can return these items, plus any other school property on the following dates:

Tuesday 25th June and Thursday 27th June 10am-11am in Main Reception.

Students collecting results in person will be asked to line up outside the main entrance at their allocated time. Members of the school team will be on hand to greet students and families as they arrive. Results will be handed out in the school dining room and students will be directed to the appropriate desk for collection. Members of the Leadership Team, 6th Form team and our Careers Adviser will be in school to offer support and guidance to any students who wish to talk through their next steps and options.


Each examination board offers post results services; these include reviews of marking and access to completed exam scripts. Some of these services incur a fee which will be payable on ParentPay or via barcode letter in advance of the request being submitted by school. At this time the precise fees have not been published by the boards; these will be confirmed on Results Day. Please be aware we cannot guarantee teaching colleagues will be present on Results Day and therefore we may not be able to provide subject specific support for reviews of marking. Nevertheless, our exams team will be able to provide support for anyone wishing to pursue this route.

We look forward to seeing our Year 13s again on August 15th as they begin the next stage in their exciting lives. In the meantime, we wish all students and families a wonderful holiday.
