

Subject	Assessment
English	<p>The Year 7 English assessment is 50 minutes.</p> <p>Students will be assessed on their Persuasive writing. They will receive a mark out of 25 for their content - structuring their answer, techniques used, level of description. They will receive a mark out of 15 for their spelling punctuation and grammar. They will then receive an overall percentage.</p> <p>The students will take their exercise books home with them to look over what has been covered in class and remind themselves of the success criteria.</p>
Maths	<p>Year 7 Maths Assessment will be 2 papers each will be 50 minutes long and will be taken in their maths lessons on the following dates</p> <p>X band: Wednesday 25th May period 4 and Thursday 26th May period 1</p> <p>Y and Z bands: Wednesday 25th May period 5 and Thursday 26th May period 3</p> <p>Students have a yellow sheet in their books containing a list of topics that will be on the assessment and have been set a revision homework on mathswatch. All topics will be assessed.</p> <p>Equipment needed for the foundation paper: pen, pencil, ruler, rubber, calculator. Equipment needed for the higher paper: pen, pencil, ruler, rubber, protractor, calculator.</p>
Science	<p>The Year 7 Science assessment is 40 mins long and will take place in science lessons, your teachers will let you know when your assessment will be.</p> <p>Students will be assessed on the work covered this year.</p> <p>Students can use Kerboodle to revise and more details will be given on satchel One.</p>
RE	<p>The assessment will take place in the regular RE lesson and will last 40 mins.</p> <p>Questions will be based on the current unit "Wisdom"</p> <p>Pupils will be provided with a knowledge organiser and links to Quizlet and should focus on learning the key terms and definitions first. Links and Knowledge organisers will also be on Satchel 1</p>
Geography	<p>The Geography assessment is 30 minutes long and will take place on one of your Geography lessons. You will be assessed on Ecosystems with a particular focus on coral reefs.</p> <p>Your revision will be from the Coral reef information in Y7 exercise books from lessons.</p>
History	<p>The Year 7 History assessment is 50 minutes and 50 marks.</p> <p>There is a revision booklet to work from – copies will be on Satchel One and students will also be given a physical copy. If it's in the revision guide it could be on the assessment, if it's not it definitely won't be.</p>
MFL	<p>Year 7 MFL Assessment will last 45 minutes and is worth 30 marks covering:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listening • Writing <p>The paper cover topics studied in Year 7 so far. Exercise books and homework booklets should be used to revise and MFL teachers will attach the revision power point and revision guide on Satchel one. There are also power points on the Learning platform in the individual language folders which may help. (Some will be in the remote learning folder). PE	There will be no assessment in PE.
Music	Y7 Music Assessment Composition NEA Pupils have been working on their own solo performance this half term. This will be completed in the last week of term and will be marked for the assessment. Revision n/a
Drama	For Drama students will be assessed on their unit 2 work that was completed just before Easter. Students will not be completing an assessment during the assessment week, but will have another performance assessment before the summer holidays.
Engineering	The Engineering assessment is an online assessment which is approximately 30 minutes. Students will be assessed on all Y7 content from the Ugly Buzzer project and KS2 content from the National Curriculum. Revision content will be posted on Satchel One to aid revision.
Product Design	The Product Design assessment is an online multiple choice assessment, which is 30 minutes. Students are assessed on Y7 content (Cube Project/ Sweet Dispenser Project) plus past learning from the KS2 DT National Curriculum Revision content will be posted on Satchel One to aid revision.
Textiles	The Year 7 Textiles Assessment will assess classwork from the beginning of the rotation to now. Students will have a lesson focusing on certain assessment criteria allowing them to improve and build on their current work and skills. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understanding of the design brief and theme • Design and development • Practical making and modelling skills No revision is needed for Textiles.
Food	The Y7 Food assessment is 30 minutes long. Section A: All the questions in this section will ask you to draw upon the knowledge, skills and understanding you have been taught this year. Section B: All the questions in this section will ask you to draw upon the knowledge, skills and understanding you should have been taught in KS2. A revision resource will be shared on Satchel One for students to revise
Computer Science	The Year 7 Computer Science assessment is 45 minutes (additional 25% where needed) Students will be assessed on E-Safety, Digital Literacy and Coding with Scratch Glossaries to support revision are available on Satchel One, along with a revision guide.
Art	The Year 7 Art Assessment will assess the most recent unit of work from Year 7. Students will have a lesson focusing on key assessment criteria and use feedback to improve their current work and mark. Work is assessed across the 5 assessment objectives. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Research • Development • Recording • Final piece • Annotation No revision is required for Art.
