Year 9 Options - Virtual Information Presentation Wednesday 19th January 2022

As you may be aware, the Government expectation is that the vast majority of students in England will now study all subjects within the English Baccalaureate (EBacc). These are English Language and Literature, Maths, Science, at least one Humanities subject (Geography or History) and a Modern Foreign Language (Spanish, French or German). This has led to some schools not being able to offer the same breadth of creative subjects previously available at GCSE.

Our aim is to always support students in making the right subject choices whilst at the same time staying true to our ethos of valuing everyone. We strive to provide students with a deep and rich curriculum experience which keeps all doors open for future career pathways. With this in mind we give our students the opportunity to make the decision to choose the subjects they wish to specialise in at GCSE.

To further explain the EBacc, its impact and the GCSE Options process we would like to take this opportunity to invite you and your child to watch the Year 9 GCSE Options Virtual Information Evening on **Wednesday 19**th **January 2022 at 6:30pm.** This can be accessed through our school website www.taptonschool.co.uk. During the presentation we will explain the different pathways available to your child, the support that is in place to help students make their decisions and how to access additional advice and guidance.
