

Subject	Assessment
English	<p>Year 8 English Assessment is a 50 minute descriptive writing assessment.</p> <p>Students will receive a mark out of 25 for their content - structuring of their answer, techniques used and level of description. They will also receive a mark out of 15 for their spelling punctuation and grammar.</p> <p>To revise students will take their exercise books home with them to look over what we have covered in class and remind themselves of the success criteria.</p>
Maths	<p>Year 8 Maths Assessment will be 2 papers each will be 50 minutes long and will be taken in their maths lessons on the following dates:</p> <p>8X - Wednesday 11th May period 1 and Friday 13th May period 2</p> <p>8Y and 8Z - Thursday 12th May period 2 and Friday 13th May period 4</p> <p>Students have a yellow sheet in their books containing a list of topics that will be on the assessment and have been set a revision homework on mathswatch. All topics will be assessed.</p> <p>Equipment needed for the foundation paper: pen pencil ruler rubber protractor calculator</p> <p>Equipment needed for the higher paper: pen pencil ruler rubber compasses calculator</p>
Science	<p>The Y8 science assessment is 40 mins long.</p> <p>It will take place on:</p> <p>Z band Monday P2: 9<sup>th</sup> May Y band Monday P3: 9<sup>th</sup> May X band Tuesday P3: 10<sup>th</sup> May</p> <p>The revision list has been shared with all year 8 students on Satchel One.</p>
RE	<p>The assessment will take place in the lesson and will last 40 minutes. The topics to be assessed are Ethics (the last topic) and Science and religion (the current topic).</p> <p>Questions will be based on key knowledge.</p> <p>Students will be given a knowledge organiser in lesson next week and a copy will also go on Satchel One. In addition, there will be a Quizlet to help pupils learn the key words and definitions and the link for this will be on Satchel One.</p>
Geography	<p>The Year 8 Geography assessment will be 50 minutes in length.</p> <p>Students will be assessed on their most recent learning and from other topics studied this year. Your class teacher will give you more information. Revision information is available on Satchel One.</p>
History	<p>The Year 8 History assessment will be 50 minutes long.</p> <p>As with all KS3 History assessments it will be a mixture of current and older topics from within the curriculum. Every student will be issued with a revision guide which outlines precisely which parts of their course they need to revise – this has been shared via Satchel already, students will also receive a paper copy prior to the exam.</p>

MFL	<p>Year 8 MFL Assessment will last 45 minutes and is worth 50 marks covering:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Listening</li> <li>• Writing</li> </ul> <p>The papers cover topics studied in Year 7 and throughout Year 8. Exercise books and homework booklets should be used to revise and MFL teachers will attach the revision power point on Satchel one. There are also power points on the Learning platform in the individual language folders which may help. (Some will be in the remote learning folder). Music	<p>Year 8 Music Composition NEA</p> <p>Throughout our music lessons last term, pupils composed a melody over a given bass line. This work is the music assessment. Pupils will not have an extra exam in assessment week.</p> <p>Revision is non-applicable.</p>
Drama	The Year 8 Drama assessment grades will be the U2 assessment mark that students are currently working on. Students will not be completing a separate assessment during assessment week. The assessment percentage is a culmination of the performance work created over a term.
Engineering	<p>Year 8 Engineering Assessment will be in the format of a quiz focusing on topics they have previously studied, including when making the Ugly Buzzer in year 7, as well as the phone holder:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Materials used in the Device Holder and their properties</li> <li>• Tools and equipment used in the Device Holder</li> <li>• Processes used in the Device Holder · Risk assessments done for the Device Holder.</li> <li>• How planning was done for the device holder · Knowledge and skills from the Ugly Buzzer in Y7</li> </ul>
Product Design	<p>The Year 8 Product Design assessment will be based on all content learnt in Year 7 and Year 8. It will be a 25 minute assessment completed online during your lesson.</p> <p>50% will assess the current project (Lamp), 50% will assess past learning (Sweet dispenser and Cubee – Y7).</p> <p>All materials to support revision will be sent out on Satchel One during w/b 25<sup>th</sup> April. Students should also use the flashcards that they have been making from previously set homework.</p>
Textiles	<p>The Year 8 Textiles Assessment will assess classwork from the beginning of the year to now. Students will have a lesson focusing on certain assessment criteria allowing them to improve and build on their current work and skills.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Product analysis</li> <li>• Design and development</li> <li>• Practical making and modelling skills</li> </ul> <p>No revision is needed for Textiles.</p>
Food	<p>Year 8 Food Assessment will be a test of knowledge learned in the following two year 8 projects:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Keeping Food Safe</li> <li>• From Farm to Fork</li> <li>• Some questions will also test students learning of knowledge delivered in Y7.</li> </ul> <p>The assessment will be 30 minutes long and is made up of exam style questions. Revision packs will be distributed using Satchel One.</p>
Computer Science	<p>Year 8 Computer Science Assessment will be based 45 minutes long.</p> <p>You will be assessed on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Y7 - Esafety, Scratch &amp; Computer Systems</li> <li>• Y8 - Cyber Security, Microbits and Python</li> </ul> <p>A revision guide and glossary can be found Satchel One.</p>

Art	<p>The Year 8 Art Assessment will assess the second unit of work from Year 8, Portraiture. Students will have a lesson focusing on key assessment criteria from the second unit and use feedback to improve their work and grade. Work is assessed across the 5 assessment objectives.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Research</li><li>• Development</li><li>• Recording</li><li>• Final piece</li><li>• Annotation</li></ul> <p>No revision is required for Art.</p>
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
