Year 13 Trial Exam Week February 2024

To fully prepare our students for the challenges of final examinations, Year 13 students will have a trial examination week beginning on Wednesday 31st January 2024. Year 13 students will be expected to attend school only for their examinations and will be on exam leave at all other times.

The trial examinations will take place in the Hall and New Hall under examination conditions. To ensure a calm and timely start to examinations, and to avoid disruption to others, students should arrive at their exam venue 15 minutes before the published start time. Students will be expected to hand in mobile phones and watches to invigilators prior to entry into the examination room as per the attached regulations from JCQ. Students are allowed to take water into their examinations but bottles must be transparent and any labels removed. Pencil cases must also be transparent.

There are several resources on the Sixth Form section of the Learning Platform to support student revision, these include:

- Revision Guides for individual subjects. These are also displayed in the Sixth Form Common Room.
- Becoming an Independent Learner (BILs) Presentations on Time Management, Effective Note- Taking, Using Exam Board Websites and Taking Care of Yourself.

Students have also had assemblies on Effective Revision Techniques delivered by Mr Wright.

Please find attached the subject specific guidance and examination timetable. Where students have more than one exam scheduled at the same time, known as an examination clash, one of the papers will be rescheduled. Details will be confirmed within the personalised exam timetables which will be shared with students in January.

In line with recent Ofqual guidance, in the extremely unlikely event that examinations are cancelled the outcomes of these trial examinations will be used as evidence to calculate Teacher Assessed Grades and completed exam papers will therefore remain in school.
