Year 11 Prom and GCSE Results Day Thursday 21st August 2025

Dear Students, Parents and Carers,

We would firstly like to congratulate all Year 11s on completing their examinations; they can now look forward to a long and well-deserved summer holiday!

We look forward to seeing those Year 11s who are planning to attend the Prom on Thursday 10th July, 6.30pm - 10.00pm at Tapton Hall, Shore Lane, S10 3BU. The dress code for the evening will be smart. Please note that the consumption of alcohol, vaping and smoking will not be permitted on the premises and the Police will be called if we suspect the use or possession of illegal drugs. Parents and carers will be contacted to collect their child if their behaviour and conduct puts them or others at risk. Equally, students will not be allowed to enter the venue if they arrive intoxicated. Non-alcoholic drinks can be purchased from the bar, including non-alcoholic cocktails. We look forward to an event that everyone can enjoy safely.

GCSE results will be released to students on Thursday 21st August. Year 11 students will need to arrive in form groups to collect their results; timings for each form group are detailed in the table below. Year 10, 12 and 13 students collecting GCSE results will need to arrive at 11.30. Students who are unable to collect their results will need to contact school in writing if they wish to nominate an individual to collect them on their behalf; nominated individuals will need to bring a form of photo identification to collect the results and arrive at the allocated time for the child they are representing. These letters must be brought to school before the end of the academic year. In addition, any students who are absent on Results Day and have intentions to enrol in our 6th Form must inform the 6th Form Admissions Team before the end of term <u>Sixthformadmissions@taptonschool.co.uk</u> Please put a clear subject on the email, telling the team that it refers to absence on Results Day and admissions. Students can then confirm their place and subjects over email.

Please also note that <u>all results</u> will be sent out via email to the student's school email account at approximately 12.00 on Results Day.

Students collecting results in person will be asked to line up outside the main entrance at their allocated time. Results will be handed out in the school Dining Room and students will be directed to the appropriate desk for collection. Members of the Leadership, Exams and 6th Form teams will be in school to offer support and guidance to any students who wish to talk through their next steps and options. Once results documents have been collected students will then move into the School Hall to exit, confirm their 6th form place or speak to a member of staff for further support. The 6th form team will meet with all prospective students to confirm places and courses.

Each examination board offers post results services; these include reviews of marking and access to completed exam scripts. Some of these services incur a fee which will be payable on ParentPay or via barcode letter in advance of the request being submitted by school. At this time the precise fees have not been published by the boards; these will be confirmed on Results Day. Please be aware we cannot guarantee teaching colleagues will be present on Results Day and therefore we may not be able to provide subject specific support for reviews of marking. Nevertheless, our Exams team will be able to provide support for anyone wishing to pursue this route.

If any families have any items of school uniform in good condition which they will no longer need please do leave any items with us on Results Day as they will be added to our uniform supplies.

We look forward to seeing our Year 11s again at the Prom and then on August 21st as they begin the next stage in their exciting lives. In the meantime, we wish all students and families a wonderful holiday.
