

Sports Day Travel

How to travel to the EIS on the bus from Crosspool to Cathedral tram stop








Bus Numbers

- Crookes Road/Lydgate Lane BUS NUMBER 52 OR 52a







When you get off the bus at Carver Street you need to walk up to West Street and continue walking onto Church Street and then up to the Cathedral Tram Stop. This will take approximately 6 minutes. This is what the Cathedral Tram Stop looks like.

How to travel from Cathedral tram stop to the EIS






The black line is the tram journey from the Cathedral Tram Stop to the English Institute of Sport (EIS).

When arriving at the EIS you need to get off at the stop called Arena/Olympic Legacy Park

You will then need to walk to the EIS (see next slide for guidance)

Your Year Leader (wearing a high vis jacket) will meet you at the tram stop to support you walking to the EIS.



Your tram will stop at Arena/Olympic Legacy Park and you will walk to the EIS.

You can see this to the left, you can also put it into Google Maps on you phone and click walk and it will guide you there.

Your Year Leader will be there to help!

There will be members of Tapton School staff there to guide you along the way.

You will also be able to see the EIS from the tram stop.
