AS and A Level Results Day Thursday August 13th 2020

Dear students, parents and carers,

Further to our letter detailing arrangements for the autumn series, we are pleased to share with you our plans for AS and A Level Results Day 2020.

AS and A Level results will be released to students on Thursday 13th August. In order to maintain safe levels of social distancing and ratios within the school building we will be inviting students to school at allocated times. Year 13 will arrive in form groups to collect their results; timings for each form group are detailed in the table below. Please note that it is essential for you to adhere to these times to ensure we do not compromise the health and safety of staff, student and parents. Students who are unable to collect their results will need to contact school in writing to nominate an individual to collect their results; nominated individuals will need to bring a form of photo identification in order to collect the results. Letters can be brought to school before Friday 17th July 2020 or on results day itself. In addition to this please be aware that all results will be uploaded to the student portal on Bromcom from 12pm on results day. Please note that this upload will not take place before 12pm on results day and will remain available until 12pm on Monday 17th August

- **We would encourage students to log on to the UCAS site before attending school to check the status of their application. If a student needs to enter Clearing, school will be open from 8am to 10am for those students only.**

Students collecting results in person will be asked to line up outside the Main Entrance. Members of the school team will be on hand to greet students as they arrive. Students may wish to be accompanied by members of their family, however, we will need to limit this to one additional person per student. Family members may wait for their children in the car park or off site. Results will be handed out in the school hall and students will be directed to the appropriate desk for collection. Members of the Leadership Team and pastoral staff will be in school to offer support and guidance to any students who wish to talk through their next steps and options. Unfortunately, we will need to remind students and families who do not need further support to make way for the next form group to arrive so that we can maintain safe levels of social distance in the building. Please be aware school will not be able to share details of the calculated grades or rank order on results day.

This has been an extraordinary year for all of us, however, we would like to reassure you before the summer that the process of awarding calculated grades was one conducted with the upmost professionalism and fairness. We look forward to seeing our Year 13s again on August 13th as they begin the next stage in their exciting lives.
