GCSE Results Day Thursday August 20th 2020

Dear students, parents and carers,

Further to our letter detailing arrangements for the autumn series, we are pleased to share with you our plans for GCSE Results Day 2020.

GCSE results will be released to students on Thursday 20th August. In order to maintain safe levels of social distancing and ratios within the school building, we will be inviting students to school at allocated times. Year 11 will arrive in form groups to collect their results; timings for each form group are detailed in the table below. Year 9, Year 12 and Year 13 students collecting GCSE results will need to arrive at 11.30. Students who are unable to collect their results will need to contact school in writing to nominate an individual to collect their results; nominated individuals will need to bring a form of photo identification in order to collect the results. Letters can be brought to school before Friday 17th July 2020 or on Results Day itself. In addition to this please be aware that all results will be uploaded to the student portal on Bromcom from 12pm on Results Day. Please note that this upload will not take place before 12pm on results day and for students who are leaving us the Bromcom accounts will be deleted on the 1st September 2020.

Students collecting results in person will be asked to line up outside the Main Entrance. Members of the school team, including Mrs Higgins will be on hand to greet students as they arrive. Students may wish to be accompanied by members of their family, however, we will need to limit this to one additional person per student. Family members may wait for their children in the car park or off site. Results will be handed out in the school hall and students will be directed to the appropriate desk for collection. Members of the Leadership Team and pastoral staff will be in school to offer support and guidance to any students who wish to talk through their next steps and options. Once results documents have been collected students will then move into the Dining Room to exit the building or to confirm their subjects on their 6th form application form. A pre-populated application form is attached to this letter, however, the 6th form team will meet with individual students who need further support or wish to make changes to their original choices. Unfortunately, we will need to remind students and families who do not need further support to make way for the next form group to arrive so that we can maintain safe levels of social distance in the building. Please be aware school will not be able to share details of the calculated grades or rank order on results day.

This has been an extraordinary year for all of us, however, we would like to reassure you before the summer that the process of awarding calculated grades was one conducted with the upmost professionalism and fairness. We look forward to seeing our Year 11s again on August 20th as they begin the next stage in their exciting lives.
