Attendance

Please refer to the separate letter regarding attendance and lanyards, however, please be aware of these main points:

- We cannot authorise any holidays during term time.
- Full attendance at registration and all lessons is compulsory.

However, if you are unable to attend:

- To report absence, please call 2671414 (option 1) and leave a message. Alternatively, text 07860054089 or email iridal@taptonschool.co.uk
- Where a student has a planned absence please e mail iridal@taptonschool.co.uk two days in advance.

If a student is unwell during the school day they must inform a member of Sixth Form staff and sign out in the Sixth Form office. We will call parents to advise them that the student is leaving school.

Valid reasons for absence from school include:

- Medical appointments
- University Open Days

- University interviews
- Work experience placements
- Driving tests (students must not take driving lessons during the school day)
- Religious festivals
- Participation in a sporting or musical event
- Family commitment, funerals etc.

Where possible, students should arrange appointments outside of the school hours. Students should also avoid missing lots of lessons from the same subject. For example, attending a University Open day on three consecutive Wednesdays should be avoided.

It is not acceptable for students to be absent from school for any of the following reasons;

- Driving lessons
- Paid work
- Job interviews
- Holidays

Sixth Form students will be issued with an electronic ID card that they must bring to school each day. This enables the school to know when they are on site, and it will electronically update their attendance record.

We will send a text if your young person has not attended form in a morning and we have not had notification of an absence. Texts will also be sent at the end of the day for any unauthorised absences that have occurred.

16-19 Bursary

Students who are entitled to Free School Meals or were PPE6 may also be entitled to financial support from the 16-19 Bursary. Please see Miss Deakin for more information.

Free School Meals

Students can still receive Free School Meals whilst in Sixth Form. Similarly, if they become entitled during their time at Tapton please let us know so that we can ensure this is received.

Important Apps that we use as a school:

MCAS – this is for parents and allows us to keep you updated with letters, information and announcements. You will also be able to view your young person's attendance and any behaviour points. We will also distribute tracking and reports through the MCAS app.

ParentPay – as a cashless school we use ParentPay to allow parents to pay for equipment, trips and to update their young person's meal balance.

Satchel One – this is where teachers will post homework, including when it is due. There is also a noticeboard where we post information for students, including careers opportunities and events in school.

Unifrog – an online resource for Post-18 Destinations available to all students.
