### Key Guidance for Applicants to Sixth Form

Students holding **conditional offers** for Tapton Sixth Form should continue with the admissions process as normal.

Although, students are still expected to meet the specific entry requirements for individual subjects, Tapton will review access to individual subjects following the release of **calculated grades** in August.

Our responsibility is to ensure that students have an appropriate timetable allowing them to secure appropriate post-18 destinations.

### Year 12 Key Guidance

Tracking for the AS Trial Exams is now available on MCAS.

Since AS levels have been cancelled students **may** receive a calculated grade.

Students **choosing** between two subjects should inform school if they now (a) know the subject they wish to discontinue at AS level or (b) now wish to drop a subject and be withdrawn from the AS level.

Students **discontinuing** a subject should inform school if they now wish to drop that subject and be withdrawn from the AS level.
